

HERO Explanations and Guidelines

Positive Behavior Incentives

- HERO points can be given to you at any time at the discretion of the faculty and staff for positive behaviors such as being on time, being responsible, and being respectful.
- Parents/Guardians will receive periodic updates regarding the number of positive behavior points you have earned.
- You can redeem them for small prizes such as drinks, snacks, sports/fine arts passes, and other items.
- If you use your HERO points towards prizes or items in the school store, it will not affect your overall total. On the app and website, you will see “Available points” and “Total points”. The available points are what you are allowed to spend. The total points are what you have earned overall.
- Students with no unexcused absences, no suspensions, and within a certain school-wide percentile of total Hero points in a month will be eligible for a prize drawing.
- Extra HERO points are automatically awarded in following ways in a nine-week period:
 - Students with no office referrals
 - Students with no absences and no suspensions
 - Students with 2 or less unexcused absences and no suspensions
 - Students with all A’s
 - Students with all A’s and B’s
 - Students with all passing grades
 - The student with the highest HERO points total
 - The top 10% of students with the highest HERO points totals
 - The top 20% of students with the highest HERO points total

Tardies between classes

- Tardies between classes will be marked in HERO at the tardy station. If you have a consequence assigned, it will be printed with a time and date on the pass. It will also show up in your HERO app.
- If you are marked tardy in the HERO system, an automatic notification will be sent to your parent or guardian.
- If you receive “Lunch Detention” as a consequence, it will be held in room 274 during your lunch period. It will be a silent lunch with no cell phones allowed. There will be a designated spot in the lunchroom for you to gather. A teacher will escort you and any others in lunch detention that day up to room 274. If you do not comply, you will receive two lunch detentions. If you do not comply with those, you will have a meeting with an administrator who will contact your parent and assign you a consequence.

Rules and procedures may be modified as deemed necessary by the Hueytown High School administration for the success of the PBIS incentive program.
